

Preparation Checklist for Virtual Physician Clinic Days

Facilitating virtual physician visits for your residents

Please check off all items below to ensure you are prepared to efficiently conduct virtual visits with virtual clinic physicians.

- Schedule resident visits for the day into VirtualCare

- Upload any relevant photos (e.g., photos showing a rash) and medication list (e.g., the MAR or prescription list for a resident). ****If any photos are taken using the iPad, remember to delete the photos off the camera app once uploaded into VirtualCare to protect resident information****

- If the resident is not medication managed through your community, ensure the resident has a list of medications on hand

- Have the following items available in the room where clinic will be held or in a travel kit if conducting visits in resident suites:
 - Stethoscope
 - Blood Pressure Monitor
 - Oximeter
 - Tablet or laptop used to connect to VirtualCare
 - Wireless hotspot (e.g., Aruba)

- Have all relevant information ready for each of the scheduled visits to present to the physician. For example, if discussing blood glucose levels or blood pressure readings, have the recent readings on hand to discuss with the physician
